

Media Coverage Summary

Overview:

Over the past few months, there has been sustained and growing media coverage on the Electronic Communications Code and the planned expansion through the PSTI Act – spanning national, regional and trade publications. The stories have consistently highlighted how the current telecoms regime is fuelling a worsening connectivity crisis, the political implications of Labour's U-turn, and the disproportionate impact on farmers, churches, community landowners and rural areas. Coverage has also reflected escalating concern from coalitions, industry bodies and landowners, warning that extending the regime risks deepening blackspots, undermining 5G rollout, and damaging trust between operators and communities.
